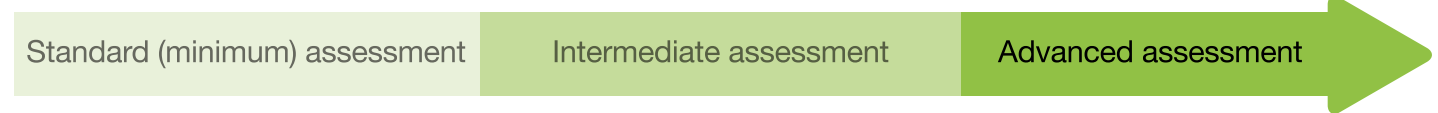

- Physician Global Assessment (0–5)
- Patient Global Assessment (0–5)



- Dactylitis
- Tender enthesal points
- PASI or BSA

## T2T PsA

### Minimal Disease Activity (MDA) Assessment

A patient with PsA is in MDA when they meet 5/7 of the following criteria:

- Tender joint count ( $\leq 1$ )
- Swollen joint count ( $\leq 1$ )
- PASI ( $\leq 1$ ) or BSA ( $\leq 3\%$ )
- HAQ ( $\leq 0.5$ )
- Tender enthesal points ( $\leq 1$ )
- Patient pain VAS ( $\leq 15$ )
- Patient global activity VAS ( $\leq 20$ )
